Greeting Sisters,

As I sat in the WMD and WJLO Inauguration Day audience, I found myself praying and calming my apprehension about the immense responsibility of being the new WMD Director. The Bible verse reinforced my constant need to seek God's guidance and await His instructions. I was reminded of the passage:

"Fear of the LORD is the foundation of wisdom. Knowledge of the Holy One results in good judgment."

Proverbs 9:10

A voice within said, "Now IS the time" to take up the call and lead in this capacity.

The Lord gave another critical insight: Rev. Chervang shared that at the start of his ministry, he committed to the Lord, "When I walk off your path, do not answer my prayers." Taken to heart, I devoted "YES! TRUTH! Lord, please don't answer my prayers if all of these ideas in my mind are not yours. Let me reset and return to your path - just like my daddy, my leader, your servant, Rev. Chervang."

Don't lead by our own ambition; when we no longer seek God's guidance, we are most likely on the wrong path. Moses is a great example. He was chosen to lead the Exodus and relied immensely on God. Each step of the way, Moses communicated every matter with God - this is what the people are saying and doing, "What should I do?" In like manner, we must do the same.

As 2023 continues to move by, pray for all UCLE, our Founder, and especially all our leaders. We are one body. Pray and thank God for guidance, patience, and understanding. Cherish unity and humility so we can create Heaven on Earth. Trust that Jesus will answer us when we align with His ways.
